Kathleen Wissinger is well-known for her clear directing style and her connection with the ringers. She encourages ringers to embody the music they are performing, whether sacred or secular. Technique drills and theory lessons are woven into

rehearsals to demystify the score and improve overall performance. Ms. Wissinger has over sixty compositions in print, covering all levels and styles. She is particularly known for her original pieces, her creative treatment of arrangements and a series of pedagogical pieces written for her school classes. Kathleen has directed teen and youth ensembles in her church for 20+ years; her current group is **AdventuRing**. She teaches handbell classes in private school and directs **Mosiac**, a community handbell ensemble. She has directed festivals and taught classes across the country as well as in Japan and Canada. Ms. Wissinger also teaches piano in her home studio in the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia.
